



To the **REPUBLIC** of **UGANDA**
**DECLARATION OF
WAR**

Being the rising of Christian Uganda against the secularist order

**For all the peoples walk each in the name of its god,
but we will walk in the name of the Lord our God forever and ever.**

—MICAH 4:5—

In order to correct a grievous multi-generational error in the politics of Uganda, and to affirm both with words and with actions that the blood of our martyrs and our fathers was not shed in vain—that Uganda is a Christian nation, and will always be—we solemnly declare war on the Republic of Uganda, with the objective of sacralist revolution; and we promise that hostilities will not cease until specific conditions are met, these being:

- 1.** That the secular Constitution be abolished.
- 2.** That it be officially recognised that Uganda is a Christian nation.
- 3.** That it be officially recognised that the islamic heresy is a criminal and murderous ideology;
—In consequence of which, islamism is banned in Uganda, the promotion of it a capital offence, and all islamic artefacts consigned to destruction with immediate effect.
- 4.** That no organisation be recognised as a national trustee, unless it is a national church.
- 5.** That no organisation be recognised as a national church, unless it is reformed in doctrine, worship, and government.
- 6.** That births, deaths, and marriages be registered formally by national churches only.
- 7.** That only such persons as are confirmed members of a national church may hold civil office.

We stand ready to further explain and defend each of these, verbally or in writing; and if the Republic of Uganda implements them, the sacralist revolution will declare peace.

However, if, instead, the Republic of Uganda persists in unrepentance and hostility, the sacralist revolution will overthrow it and establish a state whose basic policy is the implementation of these conditions, and the maintenance of the national reformation in perpetuity by a covenanted monarchy.
